

Be A Stanford Water Polo Ball Girl



We are taking signups for those who are interested in being ball girls during the Stanford University Women's Water Polo season. We need 2 girls for every home game at the Avery Aquatic Center. It is important to know that ball girls must be attentive and aware of their surroundings so they do not get hit by wayward balls.

What being a ball girl entails:

Being in the water helping during warmup shagging balls for the players.
During the game retrieving balls overthrown (either on deck or in the pool) and returning them to the team bench.

Requirements:

Must be an active member with the Stanford Girls Water Polo Club.
Must be in 5th through 8th grade.
Must arrive at least 30 min before start time.
May not leave before end of the game.
Must be attentive during their time helping for safety reasons.

Deadline to register:

Wednesday, Jan 18th.
This is an IN HAND deadline

We will compile and assign times once all signups are in.

Schedule:

We will create a schedule and it will be final.
We will email the schedule out by Jan 22 with final details and who to report to on game day. We will do our best to accommodate as many players as we can (there are a limited number of slots, or if less sign up some may double up).
